### **COMMERCIAL SPACE FOR LEASE**

### **PRODUCE GIVEAWAY**

Speeding vehicles have become a significant safety concern at the weekly produce giveaway held every Friday at Mountain Gospel Church. Please spread the word to slow down for the safety of attendees and drivers. The Sheriff's Office has been apprised of the situation and will be monitoring at random intervals.

Volunteers are still needed who would be interested in traveling to Salem to pick-up and then deliver the produce on Fridays. ### **CODE SERVICES**

The start of the Code Services program has brought to light a significant problem with RV camping in Falls City. One who wishes to host an RV camper on their property can do so, but for a limited period of time, and with required permits. Anyone wishing to use an RV for living space **MUST** come to City Hall and acquire the required permit. The first permit is free and is good for 30 days. The second costs \$25 and is good for an additional 30 days. The third is an additional \$25 and requires Council approval, so it must be submitted in time to be approved at the regular Council meeting (second Thursday of each month).

**\*Reminder-** RV's are permitted as guest quarters only. They can only be used as such on a lot with a dwelling, and must depend on the dwelling for either or both kitchen and bathroom. Falls City Zoning and Development Ordinance 2.200.05.

The Polk County Direct connect continues its free bus service from Falls City to Dallas and Monmouth. Feel free to obtain a schedule at City Hall or online at:


